Rate Basis: Fully Inclusive (FI) – includes accommodation, Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, standard Beverages - Bar (beers, local spirits, soft drinks, water and house wines), Scenic drives and Bushman walks, airfield transfers, VAT and NTB Tourism Levy.

The Foundation Levy and Park Fees are charged additionally. Imported spirits, vintage wines and optional activities as well as transfers to other lodges in the area are excluded.

Location: Wolwedans is located some 70 km south of Sesriem in the 214 836,9 ha private NamibRand Nature Reserve, an International Dark Sky Reserve.



Access: You can self-drive to Wolwedans. Coming from Windhoek or Swakopmund the duration of your drive will take between 6 – 7 hours, covering mainly gravel roads. Vehicles with a higher ground clearance are recommended.

You park at the Wolwedans reception, from where you will be taken to the camps.

If you are travelling to Boulders, you park your car at the Wolwedans reception. Your guide transfers you to Boulders – a 2 hour scenic drive through the NamibRand Nature Reserve.

You may chose to fly to Wolwedans or Boulders. The duration of a private charter is approximately 1.5 hours ex Windhoek followed by a 20 minute road transfer to the camps.

Note: Boulders fly-in airfield is Aandster airstrip, located 50 km from the Wolwedans airfield. Road transfer to Boulders Safari Camp takes approximately 30 minutes.

Game Viewing: Our nature reserve boasts with a large variety of mammal species, consisting of plains game including giraffe, kudu, baboon, oryx, mountain and plain zebra, springbok, klipspringer, red hartebeest, bat eared foxes, spotted hyena, cape fox as well as rich and diverse micro fauna in the desert.

More than 100 bird species call the NamibRand Reserve their home, a bird watchers paradise.

Activities: Wolwedans offers scenic drives (early morning, full day and sundowner drives) as well as Bushman walks in the NamibRand Nature Reserve.

Note: No morning activities are included on the day of departure.

Optional Activities: Wolwedans will gladly assist you to make Hot Air Ballooning bookings (not available from Boulders), as well as bookings for massages (not available at Boulders). Transfer to the Hot Air Ballooning take-off point, Camp Mwisho, is a 90 minute drive from the Wolwedans reception (open vehicle transfer). Transfer to the Hot Air Ballooning on day of departure will incur an additional cost.

Scenic flights can only be booked on arrival at Wolwedans and are subject to availability of aircraft. A maximum of 4 persons per flight.

Note: Wolwedans is not a Sossusvlei destination. We therefore do not offer excursions to Sossusvlei from our lodges.



Arrival & Departure: At Wolwedans we request our guests to check out by 10h00. Should you require a late check out, please arrange this with the lodge. We will try to accommodate you, if at all possible. Check in time is from 12h00 onwards. Should you need an early check in, please advise when making your reservation. We will try to accommodate you, however, early check-ins are subject to lodge occupancy.

Climate: Whilst average summer temperatures range between 34 and 38 degrees (Celsius) with almost zero humidity, there are those days when the mercury climbs up to 42 degrees. Although winter days are generally very pleasant, nights can be rather frosty and well below zero, with minimum temperatures reaching -4 degrees (Celsius).

Children: Contrary to general practise in the up-market lodge trade, Wolwedans has no objection to hosting school-age children below the age of twelve years. In fact, we have a very child-friendly approach and both the Lodge and the Camp have been constructed so as to provide a safe and secure environment for adults and children. Children younger than the school going age (pre-school age) will be accommodated at the Mountain View Suite (with private activities), Private Camp and, if booked exclusively, Boulders Camp. Accommodation: The Wolwedans collection offers guests 4 unique lodges to choose from as well as the spacious Mountain View Suite.

Wolwedans – Dunes Lodge

(9 Chalets – indoor space: 48 m², outdoor deck space: 57 m²; 1 Family Chalet)

The Dunes Lodge is perched on top of a dune plateau, overlooking panoramic vistas in all directions and capturing the beauty of the desert in a most memorable way.

The building style is a combination of wooden structures and canvas blinds, opening up to the desert beyond. The lodge reflects the ambience of a tented camp, but provides the comfort and protection of a permanent building. Each of the nine spacious chalets with en-suite bathrooms has a private veranda, which connects you to vast stretches of untouched sand. Sleeping with your canvas blinds open is just like sleeping under the stars. The main area consists of two lounges, a number of sundowner decks, a fireplace, a tea deck, a library, the wine cellar and two dining rooms.

The lodge also has a swimming pool, which is suspended above the sand.



Mountain View Suite


(1 chalet – indoor space: a total of 107 m², outdoor space: 118 m²)

With 200 square metres of deck rising above the dunes, the Mountain View Suite provides ample living space and adds a touch of luxury to the Wolwedans Collection.

The Suite is located within walking distance from the Dunes Lodge, yet it is secluded, allowing guests to spend time in a homely and stylish atmosphere. Consisting of a spacious en-suite bedroom with a king-size bed, the Suite enables guests to enjoy the view of their private dune valley to the fullest.

A shaded patio provides an ideal venue for meals and relaxed hours lazing in a hammock. Add to this a spacious lounge, bar cabinet and dining area and you have a wonderful home away from home.

In the event that guests wish to enjoy their meals 'entre-nous', an open-plan kitchenette supports the preparation of meals at the Suite. An east-facing veranda and sundeck lead from the platform into the surrounding dunes. The main veranda has a 'star-gazing' bed, which provides a wonderful sleep-out venue during summer.



Wolwedans Dunes Camp

(8 tented Chalets – indoor space: 41 m², outdoor space: 34 m²)

The camp provides a down-to-earth, yet stylish, experience. It has an unparalleled natural charm, which courts the young and more adventurous traveller.

Positioned on the edge of a 250-metre high dune, the Dune Camp sleeps a maximum of 16 guests in a totally pristine setting. The tents are pitched on wooden platforms. They are comfortable and spacious including a private bathroom. A generous deck allows for safe sleep-outs under the stars, imparting a rather civilized camping experience.

The main tent houses a lounge, dining area and an open-plan kitchen where you can chat to the desert chef, while he prepares lavish meals. Enjoy a cold drink around the campfire on the sundowner deck, where you meet fellow travellers and stories of the day will make their rounds in true African tradition.

The charm of the camp lies in its tranquil, intimate atmosphere, capturing the romance of a bygone era.



Private Camp

(1 Villa with 3 en-suite bedrooms)

Situated in a quiet and idyllic valley, this splendid Suite caters for six guests exclusively. It is the perfect getaway for honeymooners or individuals seeking uncompromising privacy and solitude.

Private Camp offers six beds with three spacious en-suite rooms, a 'Sala' where one can laze away siestas, various decks and the central lounge, combining a study, living room, a dining area and a fully equipped kitchen. Its open-plan design allows uninterrupted views of the surrounding nature.

The Private Camp is designed for those who enjoy the peace that utter silence can afford. Get away for a day or two and revel in the luxury of reading, reflecting or taking walks in one of the most enchanting landscapes in Africa.

Minimum guests: 3 persons. Should 2 people wish to book Private Camp, they will be charged for 3 people staying.



Boulders Safari Camp

(4 Chalets – indoor space: 43 m², outdoor space: 45 m²)

Situated 45 kilometres south of Wolwedans and hugged by massive granite rocks, Boulders Safari Camp is the latest addition to the Wolwedans Collection. Sleeping a maximum of eight guests in four spacious tents, Boulders is undoubtedly the most exclusive camp at Wolwedans.

The main area consists of a dining and lounge tent, a breakfast deck and open fireplace. Sundowners can be enjoyed from the top of a mountainous rock plateau close by, delivering epic impressions of the vast beauty of the surroundings.

From Boulders Safari Camp you explore the deep south of NamibRand Nature Reserve. Guided scenic drives, or two to three hour walking safaris treading along the ancient hunting grounds of the bushmen, will happily fill your days.

Boulders provides a classic safari experience and the camp calls for a two night stay - ideally booked in combination with one or two nights at any of the other camps in the dunes.
